



Thank you for your interest in University of Botswana's Graduate Programmes leading to Postgraduate Diploma, Master's, MPhil and PhD qualifications. The Master's degree programmes may consist of courses only, or may include a requirement for a written report about a research project (the Research Essay or Dissertation). The MPhil and PhD programmes consist mainly or entirely of an original research project (Thesis) carried out by the student. The general requirement for admission is at least a B grade point average in the relevant undergraduate programme; individual programmes may have additional requirements. The usual duration of full-time study is 4 semesters for a Master's degree and 8 semesters for a Doctoral degree; students who register for part-time study require a longer time. ## SGS - Special Application Instruction

Some graduate programmes require additional information from applicants. Please read the sections, below, to determine whether you must provide additional information with your application.

**Master of Nursing Science programme.** Applications are only accepted from nurses who have a valid nursing license. Please include a copy of your license with your application. You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Adult, Mental, Community Health, Parent and Child, Family Nurse Practice.

**MSc programme in Civil Engineering.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Geotechnical Engineering, Construction Management, Transportation Engineering, Water Resources and Environmental Engineering, or Structural Engineering. Students may not be accepted into all areas of study for any particular year.

**MSc in Mechanical Engineering.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Electric Power Engineering, or Telecommunication and Electronic Systems Engineering. Students may not be accepted into both areas of study for any particular year.

**MSc in Electrical/Electronic Engineering.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Electric Power Engineering, or Telecommunication and Electronic Systems Engineering. Students may not be accepted into both areas of study for any particular year.

**MSc in Computer Science.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Computer Science, Computer Information Systems.

**MBA Programme.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Accounting, Finance, Marketing and Management.

**All programmes in the Faculty of Education.** Please note that two years of post first degree experience are required for admission to some programmes. You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: MEd, MPhil, PhD in Adult Education, Counselling and Human Services, Curriculum and Instruction, Educational Management, Gender, Research and Evaluation, Mathematics Education, Science Education, MEd in Language and Social Science Education, Religious Education, Physical Education and Primary Education.

**MSc in Environmental Science.** Please be aware that the programme entails field work, laboratory work and computer analysis in some courses in Part I and in the mandatory research project in Part II. Applicants must make adequate financial and other provisions for these activities. Applicants who have completed a research project in their first degree in Environmental Science and/or a cognate subject have an added advantage.

**MPhil/PhD programme in Environmental Science.** Applicants should have competency in computer skills and in at least two of the following areas: GIS or Remote Sensing or Quantitative Techniques or Qualitative Techniques. Admission preference is for applicants who have completed a Master's degree by course work and dissertation in Environmental Science and/or a cognate subject. Applicants should have discussion face-to-face or by e-mail with a potential supervisor in the department on the viability of their intended research project concept prior to submitting an application.

**MSc, MPhil, PhD programme in Biological Sciences.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Applied Microbiology or Ecology.

**MSc, MPhil/PhD in Chemistry.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Analytical Chemistry or Natural Products Chemistry.

**MA, MPhil, PhD programmes in English.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: English Language, Linguistics, African Literature, English Literature, Theatre.

**MA programmes in Population Studies.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Demography, Health and Social Policy.

**MA programmes in Economics.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Economics or Applied Economics.

**MPA programmes in Masters in Public Administration.** You must specify the concentration area in which you wish to study: Human Resource Management, Local Administration, Environmental Resource Management.
